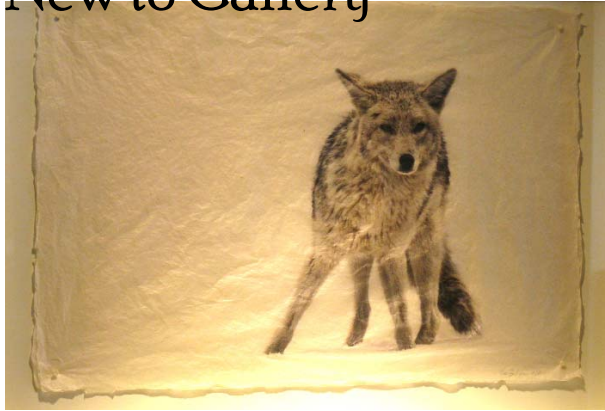
Precast Offer

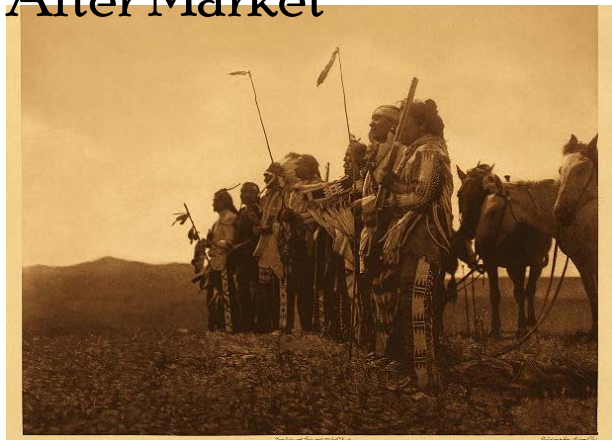
